HISTORY



Erzincan is one of the areas where the first human communities of history settled due to its geographical location, physical structure and climate. Erzincan, which has been referred as Arziya, Arzingan, Erzingan, Aziris, Eriza, Ezirgan, in the same root but partially in different forms, remained under the rule of Azzi / Hayaşa, Urartu, Med, Pers, Helen and Roman-Byzantine, respectively, throughout the history. Based on the Hittite documents, it is now known that Arziya is the capital of the Azzi / Hayaşa State (1750-800 BC). In the time of Hz. Osman (651-653), rule of the Islamic State extended to Erzincan, and after this period, Erzincan region witnessed the struggles between the Byzantine, Arab, Armenian and Georgians during the Umayyad and Abbasid periods. Erzincan, which has witnessed the influx of Muslim Turks since the beginning of the XI century, entered the Turkish domination after the Battle of Malazgirt in 1071. In the meantime, Erzincan was subjected to the immigration of large-scale Turkish tribes and was the settlement area of Oguz tribes such as Kınık, Kayı, Salur, Bayındır, Bayat, Kargın, Çavuldur, Karaevli, and Alayundlu. Erzincan, the capital of the Mengücek Melik State, which was founded in the name of Mengücek Gazi, one of the

commanders of Alparslan the conqueror of the region, became a science, art and trade center especially during the time of Mengücek ruler Melik Fahrüddin Behramşah. In 1228, during the reign of Alaeddin Keykubad, the Anatolian Seljuk State came under power and in 1243, Köseadağ War, one of the turning points of Anatolian history, took place around Erzincan. After the dissolution of the Ilkhanids, the Eratians were dominant in 1327-1381 and the Mutahharten between 1379-1403 in Erzincan. Erzincan was the capital of the local government established by Mutahharten. Accordingly, it is seen that Erzincan has been the capital three times in history. While the Ottoman domination in Anatolia was largely disintegrated after 1402 Ankara War, Erzincan was also affected by this, and it was one of the areas of intensification of the struggle between Karakoyunlular and Akkoyunlular, and the city was negatively affected. The rule of Akkoyunlu in Erzincan gained stability during the time of Akkoyunlu ruler Uzun Hasan Bahadır. Moreover, Otlukbeli War (Fatih-Uzun Hasan, 11 August 1473), which was one of the wars that constituted the turning point of the Anatolian history and took place around Erzincan did not change this situation. When Safavids dominated instead of Akkoyunlu State, Erzincan this time remained in the hands of Safavids. At the end of the Çaldıran War between Yavuz Sultan Selim and Shah Ismail (1514), Erzincan, along with all the Eastern and Southeastern Anatolia, fell under the Ottoman rule. The population of the





city was around 10.000 in the XVI and XVII centuries. The city's population did not increase for a long time. The biggest factor in this was the earthquakes the city was exposed to in certain periods and the Ottoman-Iranian wars remained within the movement area of the army. According to the provincial yearbook of 1882, the population of the Erzincan Sanjak was 59.507 at the end of the XIX century. 46.325 of this population was Muslim, 905 were Greek and 12.2277 were Armenians. The population in Erzincan's sanjak center was 16,839, and 5.280 out of which were Armenians. The weaknesses of the Ottoman Empire and the separation of the communities in the Balkans from the Ottoman State with the influence of the ideas spread at the end of the French Revolution was one of the most important reasons that lighted the fire of Armenians in the east. Russia's acts to intervene in Armenians after 1878 Berlin Treaty was one of the factors that exacerbated the events. Erzincan was one of the first places where the Armenian events increased. Although the perpetrators and ringleaders of the events that started as gang activities were initially caught and punished, the peace and security of life disappeared. As in other places, all the Armenians who were close to the events in the region were encouraged to take action against the Turks, through representatives of the Tashnak and Hinchak associations that were established to realize the political goals of the Armenians. The city was occupied by the Russians

on July 11, 1916, when the First World War continued, and the separatist Armenians, who took the opportunity, started their activities creating armed troops. Through the Erzincan Armistice with the Soviet government on 18 December 1917, Russian soldiers withdrew from the region on 11 January 1918, but Armenian gangs caused many bloody incidents. In addition to the militia forces affiliated to Halit Pasha, military units under the command of Kazım Karabekir saved Erzincan on February 13, 1918, and Tercan on February 22, 1918 from the Armenian armed forces. The people of Erzincan were with Mustafa Kemal Atatürk during the War of Independence and in the first years of the Republic. With tamia sent by Mustafa Kemal to the detached brigade and corps commanders on March 19, 1920, Şeyh Ahmed Fevzi Effendi, Emin Bey, Hüseyin Bey, Osman Fevzi Efendi and Tefik Bey were selected and sent to Turkey Grand National Assembly opened on 23 April 1920. Erzincan was subjected to severe earthquake in 1939 and the city was ruined. Thousands of people lost their lives in the city. After the earthquake, the construction of a new city up the railway was started, and today's Erzincan city was created. In the 1983 and 1992 earthquakes, as well, the city was both damaged and life and properties were lost. In the coming periods, the ideas about the positioning of the city on the skirts of the mountains in the north and west has gained importance day by day.



GEOGRAPHY



EXPLORING ERZINCAN IN GEOGRAPHY

Erzincan, located on the E80 highway in the east-west transportation corridor, is located on the Upper Euphrates terrain of the Eastern Anatolia Region. It is surrounded by provinces of Erzurum, Bingöl on the east, Sivas, Giresun on the west, Gümüşhane, Bayburt on the north, and Tunceli, Elazığ and Malatya on the south.

DISTRICTS OF ERZINCAN: Çayırılı, İliç, Kemah, Kemaliye, Otlukbeli, Refahiye, Tercan ve Üzümlü`dür.

SURFACE AREA: 11.903 km²

ALTITUDE:1.185 meter.

Mountains cover about 60 percent of Erzincan territory. 26 percent of the province consists of plateau, 5.4 percent upland and 8.6 percent plains. Terrestrial climate is dominant in Erzincan, in general. There are small lakes like Yedi Göller and Aygır Lake in Çayırılı district, Otlukbeli Lake in Otlukbeli, and Kadı Lake in Kemaliye. The biggest



and most important river of the city is the Euphrates River. Euphrate is benefited for irrigation, energy and water sports. In Tercan plains, the Euphrates joins Çayırılık stream, which originates from Keşiş Mountains in the northwest, and Tuzla water in the southeast. The largest branch of Euphrates is named Karasu from the point where the waters meet with Tercan plain. Keşiş Mountains is the highest point of Erzincan, which is on the historical Silk Road. As the outlines, Erzincan is surrounded by Munzur and Serçelik Mountains in the south, Otlukbeli-Karadağ and Esence Mountains in the north, and Coşan Mountain in the east. Tercan and Erzincan plains and Sansa and Kemah Strait are located along the Euphrates Valley located between these high mountains. In the high parts of Munzur and Dumanlı Mountains, there are rarely found wide plateaus.

ECONOMY



İLİÇ GOLD MINE

With its young and dynamic population, Erzincan continues its economic development with its social capital power by continuing its development in many areas from education to health, transportation to communication, industry to logistics, agriculture to tourism, and nature sports to culture. As an indicator of this, in the last 10 years, Erzincan has risen 7 points in terms of socio-economic development and ranked 45th, and the general population of the province has reached to the number of 222.918 together with 9 districts including the central district. Erzincan has a rich economy based on agriculture and animal breeding throughout the history with its wide and wetland and fertile plain. The city, which has gained worldwide fame with its mineral water, has shown an important development in the mining and industrial sectors recently. In Erzincan, with an area of 11.903.000 decaire, 2.027.040 decaire of this terrain is agricultural land.

AGRICULTURE

GRAPE OF CIMİN

Grape of Cimin, which is in demand as edible with its unique taste, has a sour taste. Because the sugar content is close to zero, it is a fruit that diabetics can consume as sanitary and has many health benefits.

CEREALS

Grain products are remarkable in the general agricultural product pattern of the province. Grain varieties are grown in more than half of the lands where field crops are grown.

SAKKI APPLE

Sakkı Apple grown in Erzincan region is produced abundantly in Merkez and Üzümlü district.

FIELD PRODUCTS

In addition to cereals, sugar beet, dry beans and forage crops are mainly grown in field crops.

BEEKEEPING (FLOWER HONEY)

Pure flower honey produced in our region is obtained from thyme and rattle weed plants. 1,200 tons of honey are produced annually from 77,000 hives in our region.



EASTERN ANATOLIAN PROJECT (EAP)

The purpose of EAP is to support the establishment of bovine breeding enterprises in the provinces of the Eastern Anatolia Region, breeding cattle business investments that the producers will establish with meat and combined breeds in order to increase productivity and quality in meat and milk production and to provide regional development.

OVINE BREEDING

Erzincan is generally perfectly suited for ovine breeding. The presence of tulum cheese with a proper reputation in all around Turkey in Erzincan with large upland terrains makes it even more important.

BOVINE BREEDING

The breeding is one of the sectors that is important for Erzincan. In the region, which is very suitable for bovine breeding, the total number of cattle is around 86 thousand heads as of today. World-famous Erzincan tulum cheese which is produced from the animals fed from the natural and different flora of Erzincan plateaus, also has an important share in the economic development of Erzincan.



MINE AND INDUSTRY

Among the most important mines in the provincial borders of Erzincan, a total of 112 tons of metal with 3.3 g/ton grade of gold, Chrome, 25-48% Cr₂O₃ grade with a total of 3,676,824 tons visible probability, Iron 30-64% with 24,243,009 tons visible + probable, Manganese 338,194 tons of visible + probable + possible with 15.75-86 mn grade, Magnesite 44-47.7% of MgO grade 6,849,400 tons of visible + probable + possible, Natural stone 400,000 m³ visible + probable Perlite 71,500,000 tons visible + probable + possible Brick tile raw material 1.000.000 tons of visible + probable lignite has 27.141.065 tons of visible + probable + possible reserve between 11.995.591 kcal / kg. The competitiveness of the enterprises has been increased by providing 15 km of asphalted and natural gas discount.



ORGANIZED INDUSTRY

Erzincan is developing in the industrial field benefiting from the incentives and supports of our state. The occupancy rate in the organized industrial zone reached up to 60 percent. The number of firms in production is 63, 9 in the construction phase and 9 in the project phase. The treatment plant project needed by the region has been completed and brought to the service stage. Railway connections have been made in the region where 1,430 people are employed, 15 km of roads within the region have been asphalted and the competitiveness power of the enterprises has been increased providing natural gas discount.



TRANSPORTATION



AIRWAY

Regular flights are made from Erzincan Airport, built with a new and modern architectural structure in accordance with international standards, to Istanbul, Ankara and Izmir.

HIGHWAY

Erzincan, rapidly advancing in transportation, has the opportunity of easy access to anywhere in Turkey and the world through the divided roads in highway quality.

RAILWAY

Passenger transportation on the railways is provided by Kars-Haydarpaşa Eastern Express. Transportation in the settlement centers between Erzincan and Divriği is carried out by a mixed passenger train. Erzincan province freight transports are carried out with 6 freight trains depending on the current freight situation. Sivas-Erzincan high speed train project was started in 2011, and it is planned to be completed in near future.

IN ERZINCAN

ROCK CLIMBING AND MOUNTAINEERING

Erzincan, which is mostly covered with mountains, is favorable for rock climbing and mountaineering, which are the most popular branches of nature sports. There are peaks of Coşan, Munzur, Ergan and Mülpet, which are very convenient for mountaineering, including hiking and camping. Rock climbing is performed on the slopes of the Munzur mountains close to Erzincan and especially on the steep rocks in Kemaliye Dark Canyon. Erzincan Girlevik Waterfall is a favorite attraction center for frozen rock climbing performed for the first time in Turkey.



MOUNTAIN BIKING AND TREKKING

For trekking performed in the form of mountain trekking, the mountains and highlands covering most of Erzincan, especially around Aygır Lake, are very attractive. The perfection of Erzincan geography and climate is very suitable for doing these sports. These sports are actively carried out with the experienced, trained climbers, guides and skiers of our city. While starting from Yaylabaşı, Ardıçlı Lake, Bayırbağ, trekking and rock climbing are performed on the route of Yedigöller and Aygır Lake, camping is available in Esence, Yedigöller, Refahiye, Dumanlı forests and Bayırbağ, Değirmenönü locality.



OFF-ROAD

With its rough terrain structure, Erzincan, which has become an indispensable stop for off-road fans, hosts off-road races with the participation of motor sports clubs.



BASE JUMP

THE LEGEND OF THE EUPHRATE Dark Canyon where you can see a similar view in the Grand Canyon in the USA and the Alps in Europe, is a natural wonder creating a closed ecosystem of 500- 600m in places. This valley, which is suitable for the "canyoning" sport that goes down from the Dark Canyon, which is perpendicular to the Dark Water Valley, to the Euphrates riverbed, adds a different beauty. The Euphrates River route between Kemah and Kemaliye, which passes through the Dark Canyon, has been shown as one of the top 10 routes in Europe by Kanu-Magazine, one of the important canoeing magazines.

PARAGLIDING

The International Paragliding Festival and the Paragliding World Championship Final, in which athletes from nineteen countries participated, were held in Erzincan in 2013. Paragliding is a nature sport that combines the excitement of flying with the pleasure of observing historical and natural beauty. Covered with mountains all over, Erzincan has favorable wind conditions for paragliding. Munzur and Keşiş Mountains are very suitable for high jumps up to 3.500 meters according to different wind directions. Paragliding is performed at Küçük Çakırman Village Location and Yaylabası Town Ergan Hill.



WATER SPORTS- RAFTING

RAFTING: Euphrate, which is changing but sufficient flowrate in every season, is one of the most difficult rafting routes in Europe. For nature lovers who want to enjoy the pleasure of struggling with nature among the natural beauties, rafting is possible on Erzincan-Erzurum highway, in Sansa stream and on Karasu passing along the east of Kemaliye district center.



WATER SKIING: The most suitable lakes of Eastern Anatolia are in Erzincan in terms of water skiing. Göyne Dam Lake and Tercan Dam Lake on the Karasu River and Euphrate Dam Lake in Kemaliye provide ideal still water environment for amateur and professional athletes. There are 1200-meter Çalmışla, 3750-meter Tuzla, 1550-meter Mertekli and Göyne tracks in Tercan Dam lake where Turkey water sports contest were held in 1996, and 2.500-3.000-meter of track in Kemaliye Keban Dam.

CANOEING: It is done in the Euphrates River in all seasons, and in the rivers such as Mercan Stream, Coal Stream and Tuzla Stream in spring months when the flow rate is high. Still water canoeing is done in Mertekli Regulator, Tercan Dam Lake, Erzincan Dam Lake and Keban Dam Lake. The canyons in Karasu River Valley offer highly assertive tracks for the "canyoning" sport. There are safe and enjoyable tracks for a wide range of activities such as canoe, rafting, water skiing, optimist from river and lake sports.





WINTER SPORTS

Ergan Mountain Ski Center is candidate to become Turkey's new ski center with the new technology chair lift system with a carrying capacity of 2.700 people per hour and the cable car system with a carrying capacity of 750 people per hour. There are track options at different difficulty levels for a skier to go down from the resort summit. One of the outstanding privileges of Ergan Mountain Winter Sports and Nature Tourism Center is that it is only 12 minutes away from the airport. Ergan Mountain, located at the skirts of the Munzur Mountain Range, which is 3 thousand 258 meters high in the south of Erzincan, is becoming an important center in winter tourism with approximately 12-km long ski slope. In addition, with its unique nature, Erzincan hosts many sports activities such as ice skating, snowboarding, rafting, water skiing, boat safari, mountain and ice climbing, paragliding, mountain biking, trekking, highland holiday, horse safari, and javelin. In this respect, it will attract the attention of local and foreign tourists and will become a center of attraction.

A NEW STOP FOR SKIING LOVERS WITH ITS DIFFERENT TRACKS

It has the cable cars and chairlifts of Turkey's longest lift in the length of 1.800 m, 2.662 m, 2.455 m at skiing area. There is skiing opportunity 180 days a year on Ergan Mountain where natural snow has the longest stay.



JAVELIN: The history of Javelin sport goes back to the mid-19th century in our city. Today, village youths and townspeople play the Javelin Game in weddings and holidays in almost every corner of Anatolia. There are five javelin sports clubs in our city. Javelin competitions are organized at times, and our people show great interest in these competitions. Erzincan Youth Services and Sports Provincial Directorate supports javelin sports to keep this sport alive and to transfer and introduce our ancestor sport javelin to new generations. Our city hosts the Turkey Championships in javelin sport.

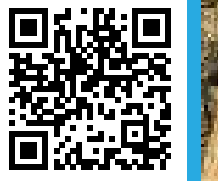

With a human-centered education approach, based on science and intelligence, EBYU has set out with the principle of raising high-quality individuals and contributing to the sustainable development of the country in line with the values and goals of our country. EBYU carries out very important activities in the fields of education, research, development and community services. Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University trains individuals who will add value not only to our country but also to the world, with highly qualified individuals who think modernly, creatively and positively, produce and use information, and represent our country in the world with their created values.

ACADEMIC FACILITIES

STUDENT AFFAIRS

An academic year at the university includes fall and spring semesters, each of the fall and spring semesters covers 14-week training period except from the exam weeks. The passing grade for all academic units at the university is determined as 40% of the mid-term exam and 60% of the final exam. If you have done homework, projects, and practices in your course in addition to the mid-term exam, these studies will contribute on your passing grade. You must have at least 2.00 GPA to graduate from EBYU. The passing grade between 35-60 is determined by the relevant committee of department. If you are a student of Medicine and Dentistry, your passing grade is arranged according to the principles of your faculty.



DOUBLE MAJOR/MINOR

Provided you want, you can apply to double major and minor programs and have the opportunity of studying in other fields besides your undergraduate programs. If you have done a double major, you can get a second diploma, and if you have a minor, you can get the certificate of the minor program you have completed. You can apply to the double major program at the beginning of the 3rd semester at the earliest, and at the beginning of the 5th semester at the latest if your GPA is at least 2,70. You can apply to minor programs at the beginning of the third semester at the earliest, and at the beginning of the 6th semester at the latest if your GPA is at least 2,35.



AGREEMENTS WITH NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITIES: ERASMUS, MEVLANA, FARABI EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

The university, with Erasmus, Mevlana and Farabi Programmes, provides you to benefit from the mobility of education in certain periods in line with the agreements with universities across Turkey and the world.

ERASMUS EXCHANGE AGREEMENTS / 20 COUNTRIES, 98 UNIVERSITIES

Erasmus is an international exchange programme suggested by the European Union for people to develop themselves in areas such as education, work experience and sports activity, offering the opportunity of meeting a different higher education system, developing a foreign language, going to different countries and getting to know the culture of those countries. Students who want to participate in these exchange programmes can benefit from the programme for at least one semester and at most two semesters.

INTERNATIONAL BILATERAL COOPERATION / 19 COUNTRIES, 52 UNIVERSITIES

International Bilateral Cooperation Agreements encourage cooperations between universities, dissemination of information, and the development of science and research. These agreements lead to the organization of collaborative research programmes and scientific meetings (workshops, symposia, conferences, etc.) as well as the exchange of students, academic and administrative staff.



MEVLANA PROGRAMME / 8 COUNTRIES, 22 UNIVERSITIES

Mevlana Exchange Programme aims the exchange of students and academic staff between the Turkish higher education institutions and higher education institutions of other countries. Students who want to participate in the exchange programme can benefit from the programme for at least one and at most two semesters. Similarly, in the scope of programme, students and academic staff from all regions of the world can come to higher education institutions in Turkey and participate in educational activities.

FARABI PROGRAMME / 90 UNIVERSITIES

Within the framework of Farabi Programme, students may benefit from the facilities and resources of different universities in Turkey for at least one at most two semesters. Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Library collects all kinds of information resources and information technologies for the education, training, research of academicians, students and administrative staff of faculties, institutes, schools and vocational schools within the university and offers them to the service of users. The Central Library, which was established in 2007, continues to serve on

the 3rd floor of Faculty of Arts and Science in Yalnızbağ Campus with a total of 104,433 materials. The Library has 11 database subscriptions and all of them can be used free of charge via ULAKBIM (Turkish Academic Network and Information Center). In addition, EBYU provides service to students, academic and administrative staff with open-shelf system, online catalog scanning system, and inter-library borrowing system. In addition to the Central Library, there are libraries within the body of Faculty of Law, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, Faculty of Theology, Faculty of Arts and Sciences, Tercan Vocational School and Kemaliye Vocational School.

COMPUTER FACILITIES AND INTERNET SERVICES



EBYU continues to serve with a reliable communication infrastructure and strong database. There are computer laboratories for student use in each department of the university and 3.201 desktops and 415 laptops are available in the university. While the internet speed is increased to 400 Mbhs, the departments can connect to the internet at 600 mbps via metro Ethernet technology. The students and academicians can perform their official proceedings online. Infrastructure services such as system room, fiber optic infrastructure and camera system have been completed in Yalnızbağ Campus. Wireless network service is provided in all campuses. With 293 AP in our campuses, EBYU provides wireless internet and EDUROAM service to all our staff, students and guests.



STUDENTS CLUBS

EBYU has a variety of clubs that can address to all interests of students. The clubs within the university enable students to develop themselves, strengthen their friendship ties and make good use of their free time. In addition to contemporary education, the university organizes activities such as conferences, panels, exhibitions, festivals and forums and invites successful people in their field along with cultural, sporting and artistic activities.

REFECTORY

Lunches of academic and administrative staff and students are prepared in the same kitchens. Dietitians serve as a control mechanism for the healthy preparation of the meals. Food service is provided in 10 cafeterias in faculties and schools of the university. Card passes are available from the tourniquets of all the cafeterias. Food prices are regulated regarding the economic conditions of the students. In addition, there are canteens and cafeterias to meet the needs of our students in the central and other departments.

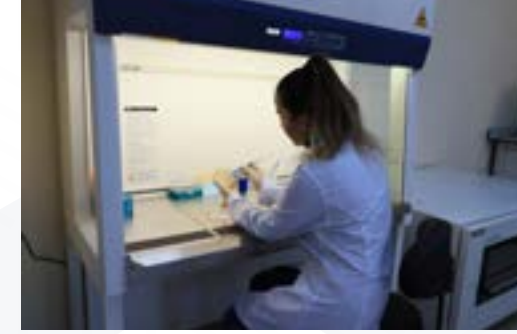

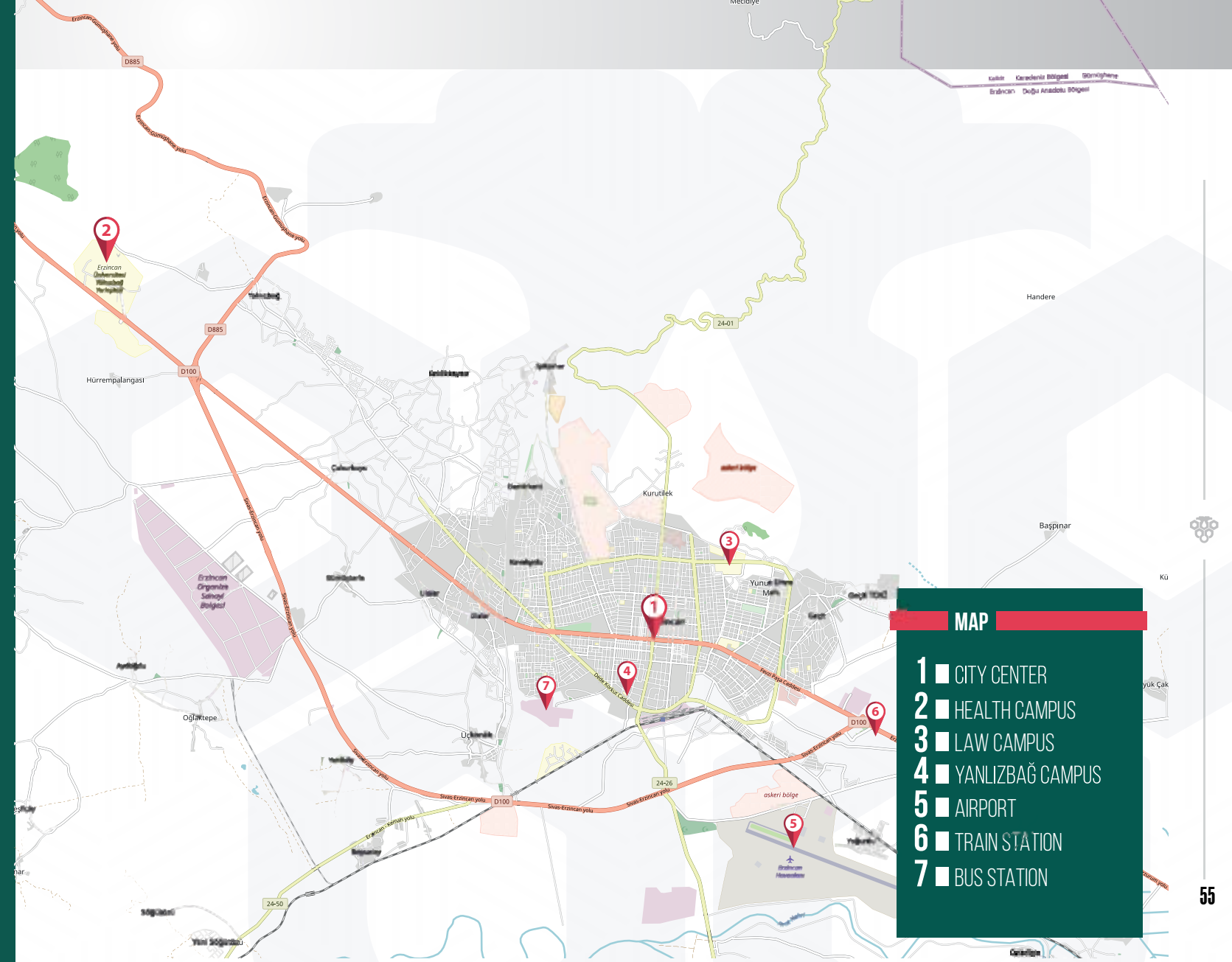


GUIDANCE AND PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING

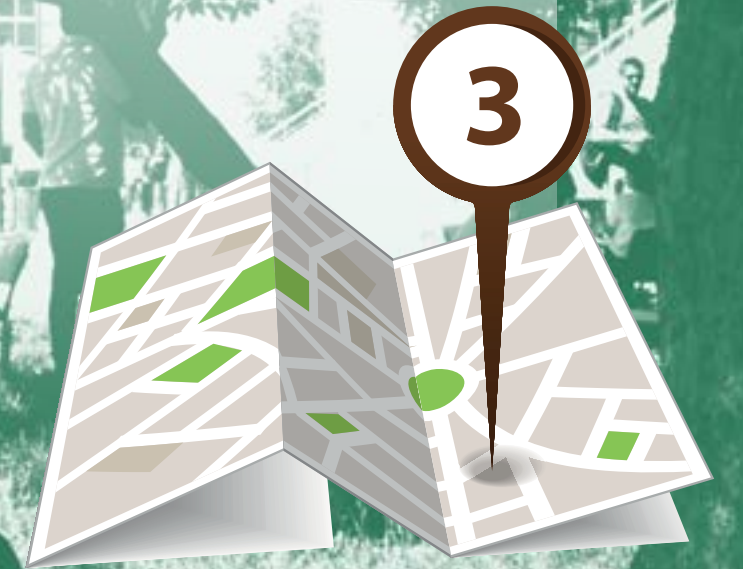

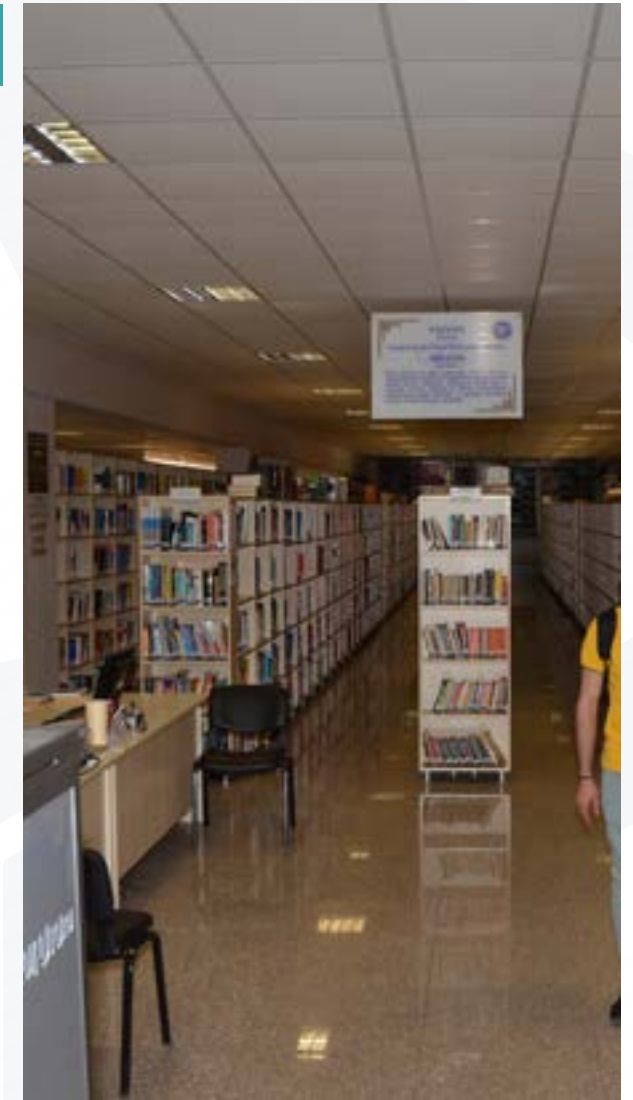

FACULTIES

FACULTY OF EDUCATION

The Faculty of Education, which was once affiliated to Ataturk University whose foundation dates back to 1967, was incorporated into Erzincan University which was established in accordance with the law no. 5467 dated 01.03.2006. The Faculty of Education carried out educational services on its campus in the city center until the end of the 2011-2012 academic year and by the date 17 September 2012 moved all its programmes to its new building located in Yalnızbağ Campus and has been carrying out its services there since then. The Faculty of Education has a mission to produce scientific information related to education through a human-centered approach, to provide educational services to meet the needs of the region and the country and to train internationally preferred teachers. The faculty's facilities include 64 classrooms, 8 computer labs, 2 science laboratories, 34 individual music study rooms, 5 main art workshops, 1 reading room and 2 conference halls. The faculty carries on educational services with totally 117 academic staff including 13 professors, 21 associate professors, 55 assistant professors, 7 lecturers, 21 research assistants as well as 13 administrative staff and 3.820 students.



FACULTY OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

The Faculty, located in the university of Yalnızbağ Campus, carries out academic, R&D and innovation studies in the fields of basic and social sciences and educational activities at the level of four-year undergraduate programs. The faculty's facilities include 21 classrooms, 1 of which is geographic information systems, 14 laboratories, 1 computer laboratory and 1 technology class. The faculty carries on its educational activities with 101 academic staff including 15 Professors, 19 Associate Professors, 50 Assistant Professors, 17 research assistants, 17 administrative staff and 1579 students.



FACULTY OF LAW

Faculty of Law, which was established in 1987, is located 3 km away from the city center on a 42.000 m2 campus, surrounded by natural beauties, where our students can do sports activities. There are 2 lecture halls for 350 people, 4 lecture halls for 250 people, 1 lecture hall for 275 people and 1 student cafeteria for 120 people. Our faculty service building has 6 classrooms, 1 hearing left, a rich library with approximately 30,000 printed works and current databases and a reading room for 100 people. In addition, the faculty offers a cafeteria for 250 people and football, basketball and volleyball courts for the students. Our faculty accepts 300 students every year. Faculty members include a total number of 59 academic staff consisting of 6 Professors, 14 Assistant Professors, 2 Lecturers and 37 Research Assistants and 22 Administrative Staff to serve for

1598 students. Besides the undergraduate programs in Law, our faculty offers graduate programs in private and public law programmes with and without thesis as well as Ph.D programs in private and public law. Our Faculty regularly publishes "Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Faculty of Law Journal" every year. The graduates from our Faculty have successfully completed the professional exams they have taken so far. The success rate of our students is very high especially in the written examinations of Candidacy for Judicial and Administrative-Law Judge. Some of our students who graduated from our faculty are working as judges and prosecutors within the Ministry of Justice, some as lecturers in various law faculties, and most of them as professional lawyers.



FACULTY OF THEOLOGY

Faculty of Theology, which aims to provide the ability of interpreting contemporary problems under the light of basic resources, began its educational activities in 2010-2011 academic year. Our faculty is dedicated to educate theologians who will conduct and publish original and objective research in the field of religious sciences, especially Islamic sciences without ignoring the social and cultural developments in the changing world order, equipped with pedagogical formation, competent in the field of Islamic cultures as well as in their own fields, having ideas in parallel with scientific and technical developments. Our faculty has 14 classrooms, 1 computer laboratory, 1 meeting room, 64 study rooms, 1 warehouse and 1 archive. The faculty carries on its educational activities with totally 44 academic staff including 8 Professors, 5 Associate Professors, 14 Assistant Professors, 4 Lecturers and 13 Research Assistants, 9 administrative staff and 730 students.



FACULTY OF ECONOMICS AND ADMINISTRATIVE SCIENCES

The Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, which aims to provide an effective teaching environment in order to educate its students as qualified individuals thinking analytic, having the knowledge and skills required by the fields of business, economics, politics and social services, adopting scientific research and development as a principle, in accordance with the conditions demanded by the era, was established in 2008 and accepted students in 2009-2010 academic year. Furthermore, lecturing procedure is lived up

with the participation of academic staff who are experts in their fields from other faculties and universities. Students' knowledge and perspectives are enriched through seminars and meetings where the experiences of private and public sector executives are shared. Our students can benefit from the social facilities of the campus besides their lectures and courses in main building with modern classrooms, computer laboratories and reading rooms located in the Yalnızbağ Campus of our University. In our faculty, there are 3 amphitheatres, 11 classrooms and 1 computer laboratory. Faculty members include a total number of 68 academic staff consisting of 5 Professors, 5 Associate Professors, 20 Assistant Professors, 6 Lecturers, 32 Research Assistants, 13 administrative staff, and 2.118 students.



FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

The Faculty of Engineering, which was established in 2010, aims to train master engineers who are capable of using the knowledge of the modern engineering world in the best way possible. Thanks to its academic staff and fully-equipped laboratories, our faculty has rich application areas required by modern education. The faculty has 12 classrooms, 1 computer laboratory, 3 electrical and electronic laboratories, 4 machine laboratories, 1 construction laboratory, 1 food laboratory and 2 computer laboratories for 45 people and 50 people for common use in all departments. The faculty continues to provide educational services with a total of 84 academic staff including 5 Professors, 6 Associate Professors, 19 Assistant Professors, 7 Lecturers, 54 Research Assistants as well as 8 administrative staff and 1.237 students.



FACULTY OF MEDICINE

Following the establishment of our university, the Faculty of Medicine was established in 2007 in order to make up the lack of health services by taking the needs of the people of the region into account. Our Faculty of Medicine has completed its technical, administrative and academic infrastructure rapidly and hereby continues to serve in Mengücek Gazi Training and Research Hospital, which was completed in accordance with the protocol signed with the Ministry of Health in 2011. The number of students of our faculty, which accepted the first students in the year 2008, is 265 in total; and our 4th, 5th and 6th year students have their clinical, polyclinic and laboratory applications in Mengücek Gazi Training and Research Hospital. The Faculty facilities include 3 amphitheater, 3 classrooms, 2 meeting halls, 2 application laboratories, 1 pharmacology laboratory, 1 physiology laboratory, 1 histology laboratory, 1 medical biology laboratory, 1 medical genetics laboratory, 1 microscope laboratory, 1 intern doctor's study room, 1 library, 1 reading room, 8 program-based learning room and 1 anatomical model room. Faculty members include a total number of 166 academic staff consisting of 15 Professors, 23 Associate Professors, 70 Assistant Professors and 58 Research Assistants, and 13 Administrative Staff to serve for 371 students. Our Faculty, which is dedicated to educate academicians and specialist physicians who play an active role in the country's health policy by continuously improving education standards, aims to become a medicine faculty in line with the motto of Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University, "Una Universa Academia in Anatolia".



FACULTY OF DENTISTRY

The Faculty of Dentistry was established in 2013 in accordance with the decree of the Council of Ministers and in 2016, faculty members started to provide health services in Oral and Dental Healthcare Clinic.

Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Faculty of Dentistry is committed to educate researchers and academicians who will take a significant place in national and international

scientific communities with the potential efficiency of scientific researches and academic publishing and contribute on the national economy with R&D activities, observe the rights, needs and expectations of patients and provide health services with easily accessible, uninterrupted and reliable modern technology at individual and social levels. Faculty facilities include 5 classrooms, 3 laboratories and 1 reading room. The faculty carries on educational activities with 8 academic staff including 2 Professors and 6 Assistant Professors, 4 administrative staff and 63 students.



FACULTY OF PHARMACY

The Faculty of Pharmacy, which aims to organize and conduct education and training programs that compete with global criteria in the field of pharmacy and that are dynamic, innovative, creative, constantly seeking excellence and can compete with the world, was established in 2012 and accepted students for 2013-2014 academic year. The faculty's facilities include 5 classrooms, 1 reading room, 7 laboratories, 1 IT classroom and 1 meeting room. The faculty carries on educational activities with 32 academic staff including 3 Professors, 11 Assistant Professors, 18 Research Assistants and 4 administrative staff and 255 students.



FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES

The Faculty of Health Sciences, which adopts the principle of educating and training healthcare staff, who are conscious and aware of their responsibilities and give importance to public health in the light of science by making use of all the opportunities of contemporary technology, was established in 2016 with the decision of the Council of Ministers. The facilities of the Faculty include 12 classrooms, 1 birth and skill laboratory, 1 computer laboratory, 1 nursing skill laboratory, 1 nutrition and dietetic food chemistry laboratory, 1 nutrition and dietetic practice kitchen and 1 reading room. Faculty carries on educational activities with including 33 academic staff, 1 Professor, 2 Associate Professor, 13 Assistant Professor, 7 Lecturers and 13 Research Assistants, and 6 administrative staff and 732 students.



FACULTY OF FINE ARTS

The Faculty of Fine Arts was established in 2018 and has dedicated to improve the artistic and cultural aspects of the students, create cultural accumulation with the field courses in art they are interested in according to their abilities, besides their professional education, and protect and develop traditional values. Faculty of Fine Arts has continued continues its targeted activities in Yalnızbağ Campus of our University since 2018-2019 academic year. Within the body of our Faculty, it is deemed appropriate to open the following departments and programs with the decision of the Executive Board of Higher Education:

SCHOOL OF CIVIL AVIATION

Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University School of Civil Aviation was established in 2009 with the cooperation of the Ministry of Transport and Çelebi Holding in order to provide qualified staff with the required knowledge and skills in compliance with the international aviation standards for the increasingly important civil aviation sector. The school, which was introduced to the education system in 2010-2011 academic year, offers four-year undergraduate program following English Language preparatory education. The building of our School has a total area of 16.000 m2 with four floors. The facilities of our School include 9 classrooms with a capacity of 450 people, 2 computer laboratories with a capacity of 98 people, a language laboratory with a capacity of 20 people and a workshop. The school carries on educational activities with totally 11 academic staff including 1 Associate Professor, 5 Assistant Professors, 1 Lecturer and 4 Assistant Researchers, 6 Administrative staff and 277 students. A proposal file for the conversion of the school to the Faculty of Aviation and Space Sciences with the name of "Ali Cavit Çelebioğlu Faculty of Aviation and Space Sciences" was prepared and submitted to the Higher Education Council by the Rectorate.



KEMALIYE HACI ALI AKIN SCHOOL OF APPLIED SCIENCES

Our school, which was established under the name of “Kemaliye Hacı Ali Akın School of Tourism and Hotel Management” in 2010, was later named as “Kemaliye Hacı Ali Akın School of Applied Sciences” in 2015. The main building of the School that was situated in downtown Kemaliye was established in September 2010 on an 11.000 m2 area in downtown Kemaliye again and moved to the new campus. There is also a student dormitory operating under the Higher Education Student Loans and Dormitories Institution within the Campus, as built by Hacı Ali Akın, a charitable businessman. The Department of Tourism and Hotel Management has been introduced to education in our School. The school has 4 classrooms and 1 laboratory. The School carries on educational activities with 6 academic staff including 2 Assistant Professors, 3 Lecturers and 1 Research Assistant, 1 administrative staff and 60 students.



SCHOOL OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS

The school was established in 2012 and started its educational activities accepting students in 2013-2014 academic year for the department of Sports Management. The courses are lectured in open-air sports facilities in the university and around the city of Erzincan and in 4 classrooms. The school carries on educational activities with totally 13 academic staff including 2 Associate Professors, 3 Assistant Professors, 3 Lecturers and 5 Research Assistants, 4 administrative staff and 344 students.



INSTITUTES

INSTITUTE OF NATURAL AND APPLIED SCIENCES

Founded in 1983, the institute has accepted students to graduate programs in Biology (PhD/Thesis), Electrics and Electronics Engineering (Thesis Master's Degree), Physics (Thesis Master's Degree), Science Education (PhD without Masters/ Thesis Master's Degree), Elementary Mathematics Education (Thesis Master's Degree), Civil Engineering (Joint Thesis Master's Degree), Chemistry (PhD/ Thesis Master's Degree), Mechanical Engineering (PhD/Joint Thesis Master's Degree/ Thesis Master's Degree), Mathematics (PhD/ Thesis Master's Degree), Science Education (PhD/Thesis Master's Degree), Elementary Mathematics Education (Thesis Master's Degree), Nanoscience and Nanotechnology (Thesis Master's Degree). The institute carries on its educational activities with 501 students.



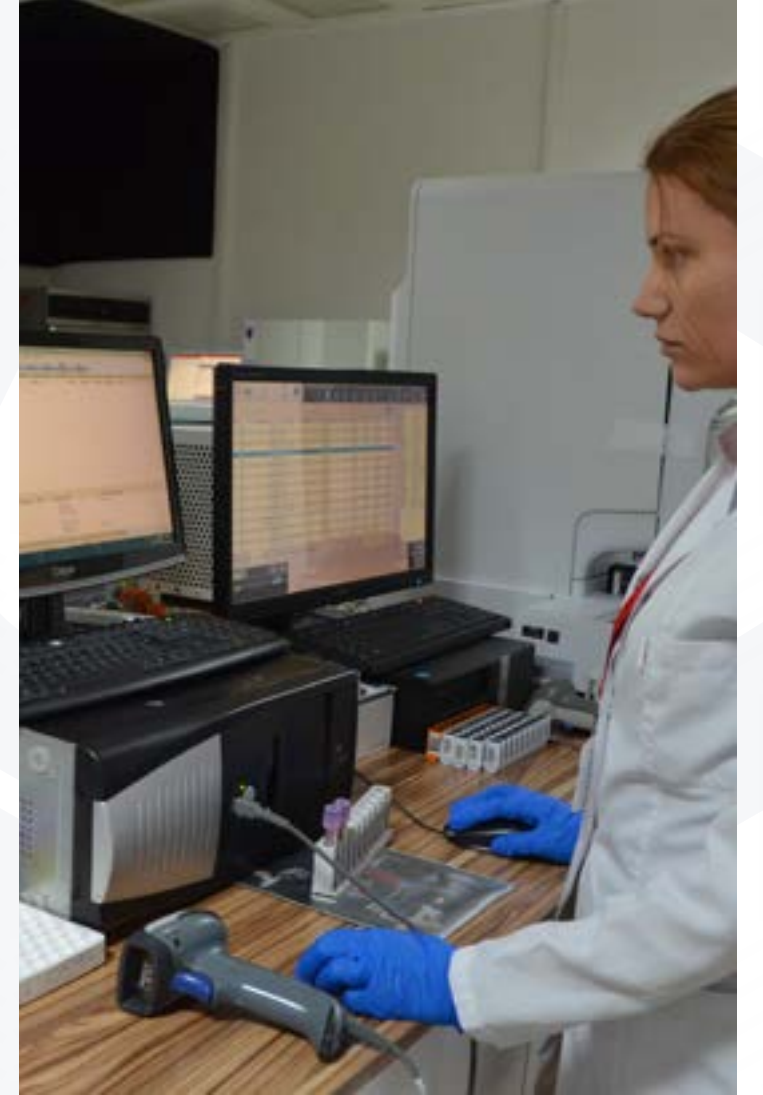
INSTITUTE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

In our Institute, the students are accepted to Geography (Master with Thesis), Guidance and Psychological Counseling (Master with Thesis) University Joint, Master with Thesis), Philosophy and Religious Studies (Master with Thesis), Painting Business Education (Atatürk University Partner, Master with Thesis), Painting Business Teaching (Atatürk University Partner, Master with Thesis), Economics (Master with Thesis), Economics (Partner with Atatürk University, Master with Thesis), Classroom Teacher (Master with Thesis), Social Studies Education (Doctorate), Social Studies Education (with Thesis Master's Degree, Business Administration (Master's Degree with Thesis / Non-Thesis / Joint Doctorate with Atatürk University), Public Law (Master's Degree with Thesis / Thesis / Non-Thesis), Financial Law (Master with Thesis / Non-Thesis), Financial Law (Master), Private Law (Thesis / Master without Thesis / Doctorate), Political Science and Public Administration (Master with Thesis), History (Doctorate / Master with Thesis), Classroom Education (Master with Thesis), Basic Islamic Sciences (Doctorate / Master with Thesis), Turkish Language and Literature (Doctorate), Turkish Language and Literature (Master with Thesis), Turkish Education (Atatürk University Joint, Master with Thesis), Social Studies Education (Doctorate / Master with Thesis), Turkish Education (Master with Thesis). The institute carries on its educational activities with 890 students.



INSTITUTE OF HEALTH SCIENCES

Our Institute has started to accept students since 2009-2010 Fall Semester. In our institute, Anatomy (Doctorate), Physical Education and Sport (Atatürk University Joint Master with Thesis), Physiology (Medicine) (Atatürk University Joint, Master with Thesis), Nursing (Master with Thesis), Medical Microbiology (Doctorate), Medical Biochemistry Students are admitted to postgraduate programs in the fields of (Master of Thesis), Medical Pharmacology (Medical Pharmacology, Master of Thesis). Our institute carries on its educational activities with 77 students.



VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

ERZİNCAN VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Vocational Schools of Higher Education are educational institutions which can transfer current and theoretical knowledge at the same time; adapt to renewal processes and cooperate intensively with the sector. Our Vocational School, which started teaching in the 1976-1977 academic year to serve for 176 students in Electrical, Construction, Engine and Accounting Programs under the Ministry of National Education, offers its students the level of education in which they can use technologies effectively and provides an academic environment that will make a significant contribution to their professional and personal development. There are 27 laboratories and workshops in our Vocational School that offers education within Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University. The vocational school carries on educational activities with 53 academic staff including 1 Associate Professor, 13 Assistant Professors and 39 Lecturers, 26 administrative staff and 3440 students. Majority of our faculty members have participated in the overseas education activities in our school which is within the scope of Higher Education Council/World Bank project. Every workshop and laboratory within all divisions in our school is equipped with modern tools and equipment in line with this project. During the 2-year training period, all the theoretical and practical information required for industry, trade and service sectors are provided with a comprehensive training program.



VOCATIONAL SCHOOL OF HEALTH SERVICES

The School has set out with the principle of educating qualified individuals who are equipped with modern knowledge and skills in the field of health services required by the country and that are in line with the requirements of the era. Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Health Services Vocational School of Higher Education started offering education and training in the academic year of 2008/2009 with the programme of Child Development and programme of Medical Documentation and Secretary Training under the Department of Health Services. Programme of Emergency and Disaster Management in 2009; Programme of Home Healthcare Services in 2013 and First Aid Training Center in 2015 were adjoined to the School. The facilities of Vocational School of Health Services include 12 classrooms, 1 computer laboratory, 1 paramedic laboratory, 1 home care practice room, 1 child development practice class, 1 design workshop, 1 first aid training center and 1 research laboratory. Health Services Vocational School carries on educational activities with 21 academic staff including 1 Associate Professor, 5 Assistant Professors, 15 Lecturers, 5 Administrative Staff and 898 students.



REFAHIYE VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Refahiye Vocational School, which was opened as affiliated to Atatürk University in 1995, has been affiliated to Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University since 2006. Departments and programs offered under Refahiye Vocational School, which develops constantly and continues to provide education and training in both social and technical programs, have been opened considering the needs of the business world. Majority of the graduates of the school can immediately be employed. The school offers education in a totally 7 programs, 6 of which is based on formal education whereas the remaining one is based on distance education. The facilities of Refahiye Vocational School includes 12 classrooms, 2 computer labs, 1 workshop, 1 library, 1 refectory, 1 student club room and 1 conference room. The vocational school carries on its educational activities with 16 Lecturers, 10 administrative staff and 927 students.



VOCATIONAL SCHOOL OF TOURISM AND HOTEL MANAGEMENT

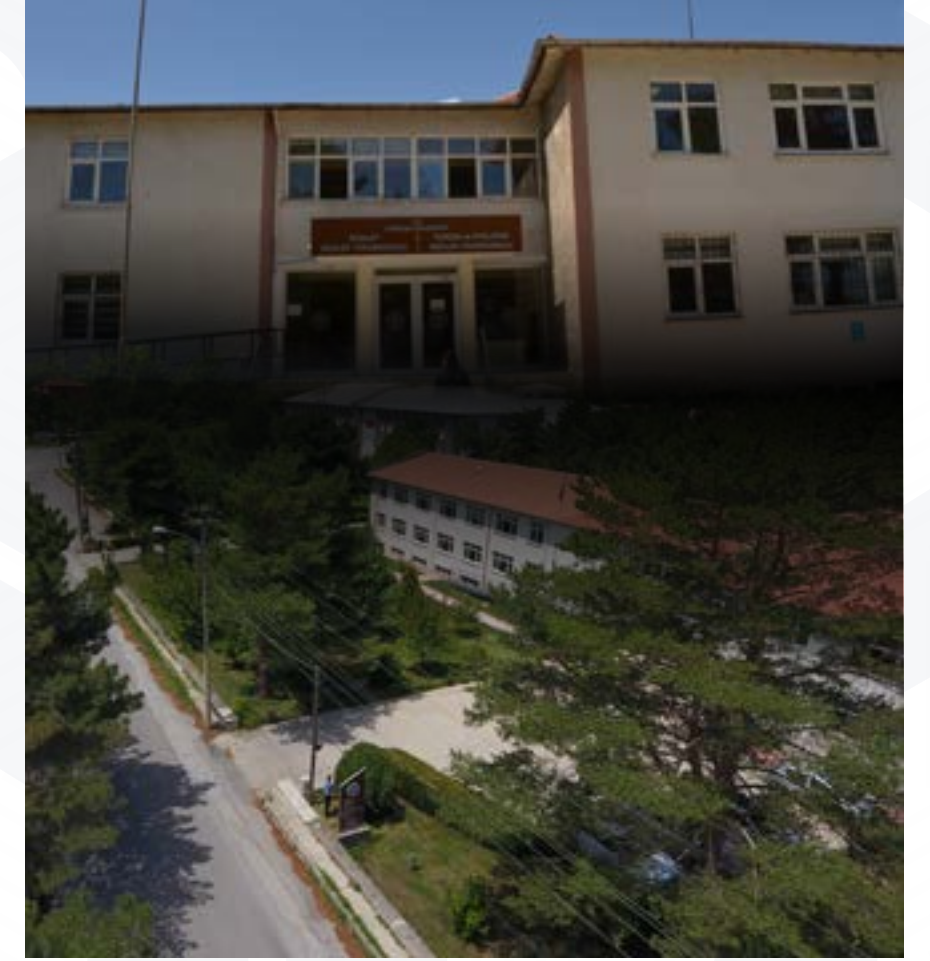
Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Vocational School of Tourism and Hotel Management which was established in 2008 for the purpose of educating and training qualified staff for the tourism sector of our country opened the program of Tourism and Hotel Management in the same year and Tourism and Travel Services and Cookery, subsequently. Graduates of Tourism and

Hotel Management Vocational School are able to transfer to various departments of the Faculty of Tourism and Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences through the Vertical Transfer Exam (DGS) and continue their careers from Associate to Undergraduate Degree. The facilities of Tourism and Hotel Management Vocational School include 7 classrooms, 1 computer laboratory and 1 cookery workshop. the school carries on its educational activities with 12 academic staff including 5 Assistant Professors, 7 Lecturers, 5 administrative staff and 370 students.



VOCATIONAL SCHOOL OF JUSTICE

Vocational School of Justice, which was established in 2010 and has offered education since 2011-2012 academic year, serves for the purpose of raising semi-qualified labor power that can be employed in various units within the Ministry of Justice. Graduates of this school are employed in Courts of First Instance (civil, criminal, administrative and tax), Regional Courts (Judicial and Administrative), Supreme Courts, Ministry of Justice (Central and Provincial Offices), Public Prosecutor's Office, Penitentiary Institutions (Prisons and Detention Houses), and Execution Offices. Graduates can also be employed in Turkish Supreme Election Council, Public Notaries, Law Offices, and Banks. Furthermore, the graduates may directly transfer to the Faculty of Law provided they pass the Vertical Transfer Exam (DGS) conducted by Turkish Measuring, Selection and Placement Center (OSYM). The facilities of Justice Vocational School include 2 amphitheatres and 2 classrooms. The school carries on its educational activities with 7 Lecturers, 3 administrative staff and 580 students.



KEMALIYE HACI ALI AKIN VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Kemaliye Hacı Ali Akin Vocational School was established with the aim of contributing to the development of the economic and social structure of the region and the country by educating researcher and productive technicians specialized in their fields. The school located in Kemaliye district has 6 classrooms, 5 workshops and 2 laboratories. Three student dormitories for girls and boys were built by the charitable businessman Hacı Ali Akin from Kemaliye and donated to the Higher Education Student Loans and Dormitories Institution. The school has carried on its educational activities with 12 academic staff including 1 Assistant Professor, 11 Lecturers, and 4 administrative staff and 415 students.



TERCAN VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Tercan Vocational School, which started education in Tercan district of Erzincan province in 1998, has graduated hundreds of "semi-qualified employees" within the last 17 years and contributed upon the employment of our country. Tercan Vocational School which provides education with its project-based and student-centered staff experienced in vocational education, educates the qualified workforce of near future. The knowledge and skills in respond to the changing needs

of our era are provided to the students through internship opportunities and professional development activities provided during the education under the guidance of their academic advisors. Besides educational activities, the school regards students' social development through many sportive and cultural activities. There are 12 classrooms, 3 computer laboratories, and 1 electricity laboratory in the school. Tercan Vocational School carries on educational activities with totally 15 academic staff including 3 Assistant Professors, 15 Lecturers, 8 administrative staff and 403 students.



KEMAH VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Established in 2007, Kemal Vocational School offers education in 6 departments. Educational activities are carried out in 8 classrooms, 3 laboratories, 1 library and study hall. Seminars and conferences are held regularly during the semester to support educational activities. In addition, the school also serves students and faculty members with a library, canteen and multi-purpose hall to carry out social and cultural activities in different branches. The school has totally 17 academic staff including 1 Assistant Professor, 16 lecturers, 10 administrative staff and 363 students.



ÇAYIRLI VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Çayırılı Vocational School, located outside the central campus of Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University, was established in 2009. There are two active programs within the body of the vocational school. The school has 3 laboratories including the ones for students, computers and research, 5 classrooms, 1 cultural center, dining hall and library. The school has carried on its educational activities with 6 academic staff including 3 Assistant Professors and 3 lecturers, 4 administrative staff and 242 students.



İLİÇ DURSUN YILDIRIM VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Continuing its education since 2012-2013 academic year, İliç Dursun Yıldırım Vocational School has 1 dining hall, 250-person indoor gym, 4 laboratories, 1 technical drawing room, and 75-person conference hall. Dormitory facilities are also available for students. The vocational school carries on its educational activities with 9 lecturers, 3 administrative staff and 60 students.



ÜZÜMLÜ VOCATIONAL SCHOOL

Üzümlü Vocational School was established in 2008 and continues to carry out education and training activities at associate degree. Üzümlü Vocational School, which tries to perceive and respond to the needs of today's and future's work life through its education programs and activities, has 10 classrooms, 2 computer laboratories, a 50-student-capacity canteen, a 100-student-capacity cafeteria, and a conference hall. The vocational school carry on educational activities with totally 15 academic staff including 1 Associate Professor, 3 Assistant Professors, 11 Lecturers, 5 administrative staff and 320 students.



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
