ANNOUNCEMENT OF APPLICATION RESULTS

Applications will be evaluated by the International Student Commission and the relevant Institute regularly following the announcement's opening. The evaluation result will be sent to the applicant's application e-mail address. Please ensure that the e-mail address you apply for is valid and active. The Office and the relevant Institute are not responsible for the failure of the student to follow the evaluation result.

APPLICATION DATES AND GENERAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

Application and admission criteria to graduate programs may differ based on department or related institute. For this reason, it is recommended that you carefully examine the relevant institute/program application criteria.

WHO CAN APPLY?

International students who will apply to graduate programs must have a bachelor's or master's degree from domestic or foreign faculties or colleges whose equivalence is accepted by YÖK.

1. Foreign nationals by birth,
2. Those with refugee status,
3. stateless,
4. Those who certify that they have a Blue Card,
5. Those who acquired Turkish citizenship after being a foreign national at birth,
6. Turkish and TRNC nationals who have completed their undergraduate education abroad with face-to-face education can apply, provided that they document it .

WHO CAN'T APPLY?

1. Citizens of the Republic of Turkey (TC) or TRNC who have completed their undergraduate education in Turkey cannot apply.

The fact that the candidates bring documents stating that they are citizens of the Republic of Turkey or that they are of Turkish descent after they are accepted to the University does not change their status at the time of admission. Students are treated as International Students in all respects until they graduate.

Foreign national candidates who will apply can apply with the school recognition certificate they will obtain from the Council of Higher Education. However, Turkish national candidates must submit the diploma equivalency certificate to the relevant institute until they graduate.

HOW TO APPLY?

1. The application will be made online at https://obs.ebyu.edu.tr/oibs/ina_app/login.aspx with the documents and application form announced by the International Relations Coordinatorship.
2. During the Online Application, it is obligatory to upload the documents (Transcript Document, Graduation Certificate, Curriculum Vitae, Foreign Language Exam, etc.) and other documents, if any, required in the relevant programs to the system. The application will be deemed invalid if the information is inaccurate or the documents are incompletely uploaded.
3. Documents received via e-Government are accepted in applications.
4. Applications by mail will not be accepted.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

Application requirements may vary from program to program. Please carefully examine the tables showing the quota and application condition(s) of the program you will apply for.

1. To have a bachelor's degree recognized by YÖK for Master's programs and a master's degree for doctoral programs. Until the equivalence certificate reaches the relevant Graduate School, the student's registration will be made conditionally. If the equivalence certificate is not delivered, the student's registration will be deleted. The student will apply considering this situation. The student candidate is deemed to have accepted all these provisions and cannot claim any rights when his/her registration is deleted.
2. Undergraduate grade point average must be at least 60 out of 100.
3. International students applying to the doctoral program must have at least 55 points from the central foreign language exams accepted by YÖK, other than their mother tongue, or have an equivalent score from the international foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted and the international foreign language exams whose equivalence is accepted within the scope of "ÖSYM-Foreign Language Exams Equivalence".
4. Turkish language proficiency is not required for the application; However, in case of final registration, B2 Turkish language level is required for Master's programs and doctoral programs in order to start the courses. C1 language proficiency is mandatory in master's and doctoral programs in order to proceed to the thesis stage. A Turkish Proficiency certificate is not required from foreign applicants who have completed their undergraduate/graduate education in Turkey.
5. The candidate should not have been dismissed from a higher education institution in Turkey due to a disciplinary offense,
6. An application can only be made to one program. If a negative result is obtained from the first evaluation during the application period, an application can be made to another program that meets the conditions.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO APPLY

1. **Diploma** (Bachelor's diploma for Master's programs; copy of bachelor's and master's diplomas for doctorate programs, as well as a copy of the Turkish translation approved by official authorities-foreign representatives- or notarized),
2. **Transcript** of the document and Turkish translation by official authorities -foreign representations- approved or notarized copies (undergraduate/graduate),
3. **Photocopy of passport/ID** document and notarized Turkish translation,
4. **Curriculum vitae/CV** (in Turkish or English), including education and academic experience.
5. **One biometric photo**
6. **Document showing foreign language proficiency** (for doctoral programs). Foreign applicants must have obtained the required score from the central foreign language exam, the equivalence of which is accepted by OSYM, in one of the languages English, German, French, Italian, Spanish, Russian, Arabic, Chinese, Japanese and Persian, as stipulated by the program they are applying to.
7. **Letter of intent** (in Turkish or English), including which major to receive education, the reason for the request for education, the field in which he wishes to improve himself, and short and long-term goals

APPLICATION PRE-EVALUATION

The International Student Commission examines the documents for correctness and incompleteness; if there is no deficiency or inaccuracy, they are forwarded to the relevant institute. Matters subject to preliminary assessment:

- Submission of mandatory documents,
- The accuracy of the documents showing the score,
- The documents are approved,
- Compliance of the graduation area with the requirements of the department applied for.

EVALUATION

Candidates who submit the above-required documents are evaluated by the department to which they have applied on the specified dates. A "Letter of Acceptance" is sent to the candidates who are found successful as a result of the final evaluation. Students to whom a letter of acceptance is sent make their final registration by sending the documents required below to EBYU between the registration dates specified in the academic calendar .

After the evaluation of the applied department, an admission certificate is given to the placed candidate.

1. Points are evaluated by converting to 100 systems. The conversion table accepted by the Council of Higher Education will be used to convert the graduation grade point averages from the 4-point system to the 100-point system.
2. Candidates who meet the application conditions are evaluated by the head of the relevant department. Admission of students takes place with the approval of the Institute Administrative Board.
3. In graduate applications, 70% of the undergraduate grade point average and 30% of the Turkish Proficiency Certificate score are considered.
4. In doctoral applications, 70% of the graduate grade point average and 30% of the Turkish Proficiency Certificate score are considered.
5. The language certificate score of the candidates who do not have a Turkish Proficiency certificate is evaluated as 0 (zero).
6. Candidates who are entitled to Final Registration; According to the European Language Portfolio evaluation, candidates whose Turkish Language Proficiency score is below the B2 level or who do not have any language proficiency certificate take the exam held by the University Language Education Application and Research Center. Students who pass the exam or present a B2 level Turkish proficiency certificate to the institute can enroll in the relevant master's/doctorate programs; however, they have to document the C1 proficiency level in order to proceed to the thesis stage. Students who fail the exam have to continue their Erzincan TÖMER education.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

1. The application results are announced on the internet pages of EBYU, International Relations Coordinatorship and related institutes.
2. **Pre-registration is done by the** International Relations Coordinatorship, and **final registration** is done by the related institute student affairs unit.

FINAL REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

International students should carefully read the Final Enrollment Guide published with the announcement of the results for the entire process after they are accepted to the program they are applying for, and follow the process in line with this guide.

If the student completes the visa procedures with this document, pays the tuition fee and registers for the course, the final registration process is carried out.

TUITION FEE

In cases where they are not exempted by bilateral agreements, international students are obliged to pay the fees determined by the University Administrative Board within the framework of the Presidential Decision. The tuition fee for all programs is **4,000 TL**. It is paid in two equal installments as Fall and Spring semesters.

MISCELLANEOUS AND FINAL PROVISIONS

Cases Without Provisions

(1) In cases where there is no provision in this guide, Erzincan Binali Yıldırım University Graduate Education and Examination Regulation, the decisions of the Institute and International Student Admission Commission, and other legislation provisions are applied.

Force
